We, as a community, have evolved a great deal, and this is a big step forward in developing a better, healthier community. This was made possible with all of your support, and we could not have done this without you. Alhamdulillah now it will be possible to attend the health needs of the community along with previously provided social, educational, and religious needs.

About Free Clinic:

We did an environmental scan and could not help but notice that 6.77% of Lehigh Valley community are uninsured, not to mention people who are underinsured. It means 6.77% of Lehigh Valley community has no access to standard primary care, with many more having limited access to it. This brought to our attention the dire need of a free community clinic to help these people get the appropriate healthcare they deserve.

Starting Jan 2021, MALV Free Clinic will be a non-profit free-of-charge clinic open for all regardless of their ethnicity, social, religious, or economic status, which will strive to provide quality healthcare to the Lehigh Valley community. This will be a state-of-the-art primary healthcare clinic with standardized care delivered by physicians trained by the top hospitals of the area. MALV free clinic will be an excellent resource for uninsured or underinsured people who do not have access to primary healthcare leading to complications associated with chronic diseases. We especially appreciate the underserved community to use our medical services at MALV free clinic. MALV free clinic, aside from meeting the community healthcare needs, also sends a strong message that Muslims are peace-loving people and an active part of this community trying to make a difference.

Timings and scheduling:

We will be starting MALV free clinic as a walk-in facility with no scheduling needed. We are starting small with plans to expand as required In Sha Allah. We will have one exam room, and the waiting area and timings will be 10 am-2 pm every Sunday. We will assess the need to expand once it is operational and will plan the expansion accordingly.
